Membership is also available to those actively participating in Alanon or Alateen meetings with 6 months of recovery. As a condition of membership, all members agree to uphold and abide by the Changing Lanes Alano Club Code of Ethics, which is designed to ensure a respectful and supportive environment for all.

CHANGING LANES ALANO CLUB CODE OF ETHICS & CONDUCT

Respect and Diversity

Treat all members, visitors, and staff with respect and honor the diversity within the club.

Accountability

Be accountable for your words and actions, keeping in mind that they may reflect the club and the recovering community in general.

Substance-Free Environment

The club is a substance-free environment. No alcohol, drugs, or intoxicants are allowed on the premises to ensure a safe and supportive space for everyone.

Ethical Demeanor

Maintain an ethical demeanor during all club interactions. Boundaries between personal and professional relationships must be respected.

Confidentiality and Anonymity

Respect the confidentiality of club matters and maintain the anonymity of other members and visitors. Information shared within the club should not be disclosed to outsiders.

Conflict Resolution

In case of conflicts or disagreements, seek group leadership or mediation to resolve issues amicably and peacefully.

Respect for Property

Members and visitors must respect club property and facilities, use them responsibly, maintain their condition, and report any damage immediately. Leave club property in good condition for others.

Reporting Unacceptable Behavior

If members or visitors observe unacceptable behavior, they are encouraged to speak up for a safer community.

Cleanliness

Help keep the club clean. Dispose of trash properly and clean up after yourself.

Criminal Activity

Any criminal activity, including stealing, battery, destruction of property, and sexual misconduct, will be reported to the authorities to maintain a safe and law-abiding environment.
